Auf der Passagierliste der Bark „Constitution“, Abfahrt Bremerhaven am 07.05.1845, Ankunft New Orleans am 23.06.1845, sind neun Lohner Auswanderer aufgeführt – u.a.:

- *Taphorn Wilhelm. 22, Merschendorf, Ziel: Cincinnati* *2

Hierbei handelt es sich um Wilhelmina Margaretha, geb. 24.04.1823 in Lohne-Märschendorf.

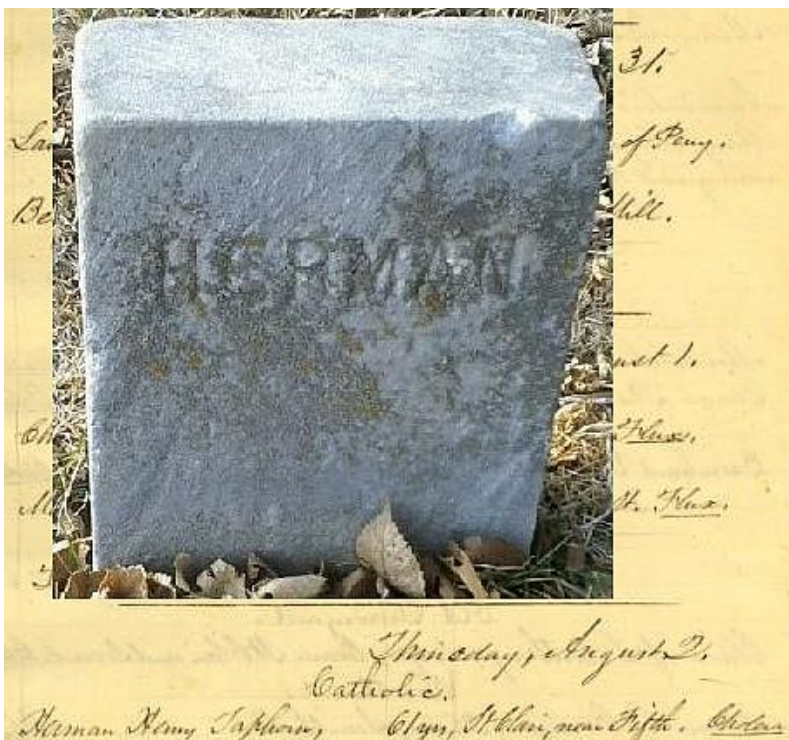
Eine weitere Auswandererkartei des Schiffes „Manchester“, Abfahrt Bremerhaven am 19.08.1846, Ankunft in Baltimore am 13.10.1846 zeigt die jüngste Schwester und die Eltern:

- *Taphorn Heinrich 60(*1786), Farmer in Messendorf, Germany, Ziel: U.S.* *2

- *Taphorn Margaret 18(*1828), Taphorn Elizabeth 55(*1791) aus Meschendorf, Germany, Ziel: U.S.* *2

Bei der Suche nach deren Verbleib konnte festgestellt werden, dass die ganze Familie ausgewandert ist:

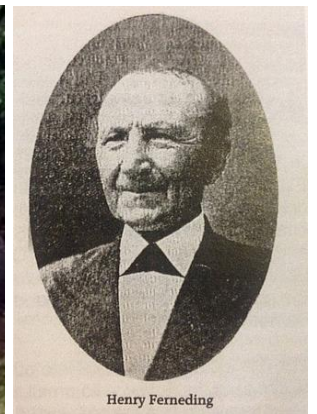
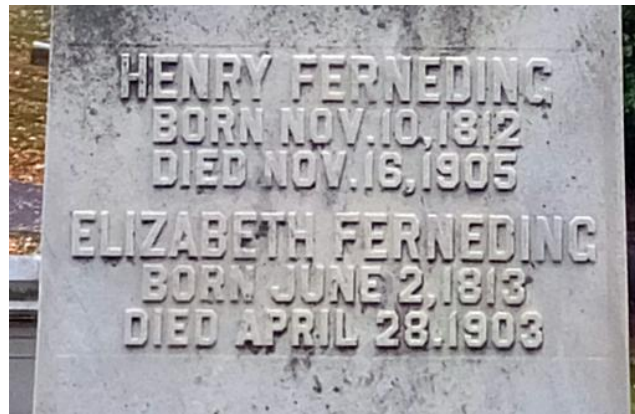

A BEAUTIFUL LIFE IS ENDED NOW

Mrs. Elizabeth Ferneding Passes Away at Age of Ninety Years.

The death of the venerable Mrs. Elizabeth Ferneding occurred at her home on East Third Street late Monday night. The deceased was 90 years of age, and is survived by her husband, Henry Ferneding, who is one years older than his wife. The couple had been married for 63 years and for over 50 years have lived on East Third Street.

Mrs. Ferneding was also the mother of Mr. C. J. Ferneding, the president of the Dayton and Xenia traction line.

She was born in Dinklage, Grand Duchy of Oldenberg, Germany. She came to this country with her parents while quite young. They first lived in New Orleans. From there they moved to Cincinnati and then to Dayton.

In 1840 she was married to Henry Ferneding. She was a noble Christian woman, and was beloved by a host of friends and acquaintances. Her peaceful death was a fitting end to a long and beautiful life, which was full of deeds of charity.

Mr. and Mrs. Ferneding were members of Holy Trinity church, from which place the funeral will be held Friday morning at 9 o'clock. The interment will be made at Calvary.
